MOTION ON THE STRUGGLE OF THE PEOPLES AGAINST THE IMPERIALIST WAR Our Party, founded by José Carlos Mariátegui on October 7, 1928, sends its Marxist-Leninist greetings to all the participants and fighters for the liberation of our peoples.

Our Party maintains that our inalienable ideological basis is Marxism-Leninism. We maintain that we are living in the epoch of imperialism and proletarian revolutions, as the great LENIN pointed out in his masterful work IMPERIALISM THE HIGHEST STAGE OF CAPITALISM.

This epoch is characterized by the development of parasitic capitalism.

While it is true that our country is a capitalist society we see that it is a dependent capitalism and our society is still backward. The independence of 1821 was not an economic one.

The successive governments during these two centuries have been SELLOUTS.

The economy is extractivist. It does not help to develop the productive forces. In reality, the 1993 constitution is deepening the looting.

Labor rights are being violated. We need to forge a great anti-fascist and anti-imperialist front on a global scale. At the same time as the bourgeoisie is developing its inter-imperialist struggles for new redivisions of the world, it is also developing concerted action to take away the rights won in historic struggles from the workers and peoples of the world by imposing the neoliberal model on a global scale.

We have no hope in countries like China or Russia since they are capitalist countries that are also in the fight to snatch away from the peoples their natural wealth, as we see in Peru where Chinese capitalism has taken over large tracts of land. This is affecting the peoples and communities, it is even affecting the national population as a whole as a result of the contamination with heavy metals of the waters that irrigate the valleys, including drinking water for human consumption of the more than 10 million inhabitants of the city of Lima, capital of Peru.

The Peruvian people voted overwhelmingly for change by electing Pedro Castillo as president, but a year after assuming office he has not shown signs or the slightest intention of changing the neoliberal constitution of Fujimori's crimes.

Moreover, he continues to grant concessions of communal territories to Chinese or U.S. transnational corporations. He is following the policy of denying the workers their labor rights and shows no sign of wanting to stop the process of privatization of education.

The Peruvian people reject the Fujimori congressmembers.

But that does not mean accepting the neoliberalism of the policy developed by Pedro Castillo. In this sense, we must prepare for the struggle for the restitution of the validity of the 1979 constitution, the nullification of the neoliberal criminal Fujimori constitution and the convocation of a constituent assembly.

In addition to annulling all the concessions made without due prior consultation, as are the cases of the provinces of Islay de Arequipa, Vilcashuaman in Ayacucho, San Ignacio de Cajamarca, Huancabamba and Ayabaca in Piura, the expansion of concessions have also not been consulted as are the cases of Apurímac and the provinces of Sara Sara in Ayacucho. The struggle of the workers for the restoration of their labor rights and [their] outsourcing, as well as the legitimate defense of pension rights and the struggle of the youth against the privatization of education, and the rights of street workers and for the restitution of their civil rights as Peruvian citizens who exercise their free right not to be VACCINATED in accordance with Law 31091 and the Nuremberg Declaration.
